THE ROLE

As our highly valued volunteer co-ordinator you will recruit, support and manage the volunteering programme 'Give-Gain-Grow' in Chelsea and Fulham.

One of your key priorities will be to ensure our volunteers have a fulfilling volunteering experience with us and maximise their potential.

You'll be responsible for managing and co-ordinating the volunteers, identifying and developing new community outreach projects and seeking out fundraising opportunities.

With the volunteer co-ordinator post we aim to build our capacity to reach the local community through volunteers. It will provide opportunities for people to give back, gain skills and work experience, and grow in their faith and calling. In this role you will also support a range of services and activities provided by Chelsea and Fulham Methodist Church.

- Advance the church's work and outreach – including reaching more disadvantaged people within our community who are experiencing poverty
- Enable us to encourage these individuals and families to increase their engagement with us and access the care and support they need
